Dear Customers,

The City of Quinlan and Cash SUD, the City's wholesale water provider, are experiencing all-time highs in water usage. This is partially attributed to new growth in our service areas, and drought conditions are setting in for over 84% of Texans, which seems likely to become worse.

We are informing you of this issue and asking that customers begin conserving water, by reducing lawn watering, not being wasteful when washing vehicles, not leaving sinks running, and making sure that leaks of any kind, be fixed as quickly as possible. If large amounts of water usage do become necessary, such as pool refills, we encourage that this be done during none peak hours during the night.

The City of Quinlan is also trying to reduce our water usage where we can. There is some mandatory flushing of main lines that has to be done in order to stay in compliance with TCEQ regulations, but we are trying to be mindful of the shortages and flushing only as needed.

We are trying to be proactive and get ahead of mandatory water restrictions that can be imposed on the City of Quinlan by Cash SUD, and NTMWD from whom they purchase a portion of their water. If water cannot be conserved voluntarily, this will be the end result, with restrictions growing stricter with higher water usage and worsening drought conditions.
